The Angus Robinson, Jr. Memorial Foundation	Scholarship awards of up to \$5,000 per applicant will be made to qualified students who are enrolled in a four-year insurance, risk management or actuarial science degree program.
Insurance Scholarship Foundation of America	College Scholarships are awarded to juniors and seniors whose course of study is working toward a degree in Insurance, Risk Management and Actuarial Science
Spencer Educational Foundation, Inc.	The Spencer Educational Foundation awards full time scholarships. Full-time students must have enrolled in 9-12 credits per semester to be considered for a full-time scholarship.
